All the senior students of the college are informed not to indulge in such activities in or outside of the campus. If found, strict action will be taken against the guilty as per the anti-ragging act of Government of Maharashtra which states:

- 1. Penalty for ragging:** Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within or outside any education institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extend to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- 2. Dismissal of student:** Any student convicted of an offence under section 4 shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- 3. Suspension of student :** Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian, or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and if; prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated, for further action.

It is our appeal that nobody should comment or criticize religion, caste and creed. If found guilty, the college will first rusticate the student and then handover the case to the police station.

All are appealed to follow the rules and regulations of the college.

## MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999

“The most inhumane act is the offence of Ragging on a human being by an inhuman creature.”



Ragging is an offence under MAHARASHTRA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT, 1999

which defines ragging as:

Action against ragging: Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 and Prevention and Prohibition of Ragging (Appendix 12 published in AICTE Approval Process Handbook (2011-12) and their amendments which may be published from time to time. The Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999 is in effect from 15th May, 1999 has the following provisions for Action against Ragging.

- a) Ragging within or outside institution is prohibited,
- b) Whosoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets, or propagates ragging within or outside institution shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term up to 2 years and / or penalty, which may extend to ten thousand rupees.
- c) Any student convicted of an offence of ragging shall be dismissed from the educational institution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of five years from the date of order of such dismissal.
- d) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the Head of the Institution, the Head of the Institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the

complaint and if, prime facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the institution is situated, for further action. Where, on enquiry by the

Head of the Institution, it is found that there is no substance, prima facie, in the complaint received;

he / she shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant. The decision of the Head of the Institution shall be final. Our Institute has constituted Anti-Ragging committee in which all the faculty members and entire staff of our institute are the members.
